

MARINE SUMMER FIELD TRIP PROGRAM

The Marine Summer Field Trip Program is a partnership between New York Sea Grant, the New York State Department of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation at the Jones Beach Energy and Nature Center, and Cornell Cooperative Extension of Nassau County. This field trip experience was developed for students aged 8-12 years old to connect with marine and coastal educational resources. The Program features interactive and engaging activities including seining to identify marine life, exploring coastal habitat and wildlife, lessons about important coastal issues, introduction to common shoreline hazards, basic water safety, and much more!

Walk-ins are not accepted and group leaders must register to reserve a session. Each session is from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm. *Ask about the transportation grant that is available through the Connect Kids to Parks Program. Registration opens on May 1, 2026, until the Program is fully booked.
