Application Checklist

Applications must include the following twelve elements (see pages 7-11 of the Federal Funding Opportunity announcement for details and instructions for each element):

I. Project Narrative

- __1. Signed title page.
- __2. Project summary (Applicants must use the Sea Grant Project Summary Short Form 90-2).
- __3. Project proposal (5 pages max):
 - A. Summary
 - B. Rationale
 - C. Objectives and/or hypotheses to be tested
 - D. Methods
 - E. Relevance of results.
- __4. Curriculum vitae of the student, the faculty advisor, and the NMFS mentor (2 page maximum per individual).
- __5. Signed letter of commitment from the prospective NMFS mentor.
- __6. Official transcripts or copies of all official undergraduate and graduate student transcripts.
- __7. Summary of academic training in quantitative methods.
- __8. Education and career goal statement (2 pages max).
- __9. Three signed letters of recommendation, including one from the student's faculty advisor.
- __10. Proof of acceptance.
- __12. Abbreviated Environmental Compliance Questionnaire.
- __13. Data Management Plan (2 pages max).

II. Budget Narrative

- __1. Sea Grant 90-4 Form.
- __2. Budget Justification.

III. Overall Application
