You are an Invasive Species Investigator and you are informing the public about sea lamprey. You will create a “Most Wanted” flyer using the information you just learned about your invasive species.

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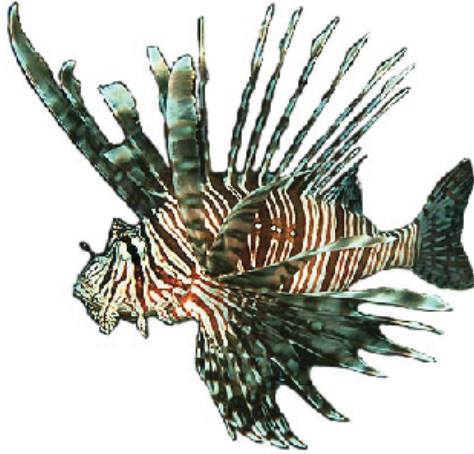
## RUDD
